Meals

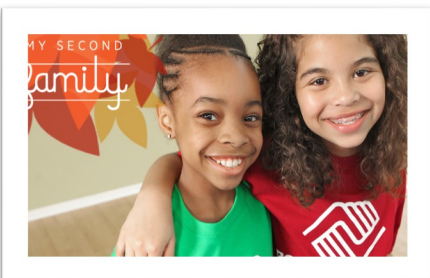
Children are provided a meal that will cover all 5 essential food groups daily. Your child does not have to take a meal, or eat everything on their tray.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Youth must be enrolled in 1st to 12th grade.
- Every youth must submit a completed membership application that is signed and completed by a parent/guardian.
- Youth that may require additional accommodations must meet with Club leadership to discuss & make a decision on ability to meet accommodations.
- Membership begins 24 hours after new member orientation completion
- Youth must be able to use the bathroom without assistance (potty trained).
- Club Membership costs \$10 per year
- Your child must be picked up prior to closing time (6:30pm SY & 5:30pm SMR). Failure to do so will result in your child being held by DHS.
- If your child did not attend school, they will not be allowed to attend the club that day.
- The Club is a DROP-IN CENTER, i.e. your child is free to attend anytime M-F during Club hours of operation.
- BGCWTV follows the local school district's schedule and is closed on non school days, except spring break.
